Are you shy about speaking in public? If so, take a trip to Ireland and join the millions who've made the pilgrimage to Blarney Castle to kiss The Stone of Eloquence, or the Blarney



Blarney Castle - The original stone fortification, built around 1210, was destroyed in 1446, but rebuilt by Cormac Laidir MacCarthy

Stone. Hanging upside down from the castle battlements and kissing the stone is said to give one "the gift of gab," or the ability to speak with confidence. Which President Served Two Non-Consecutive Terms?

America has had many two-term presidents in its history, but only one who served two non-consecutive terms: Grover Cleveland. Born in 1837 in Caldwell, New Jersey, Cleveland became a lawyer in Buffalo, New York and

was appointed district attorney of Erie County in 1863. Aligning himself with the Democratic Party, he began his political journey from being elected Sheriff of Erie County to Mayor of Buffalo to Governor of New York before narrowly winning the presidency in 1885, only the second bachelor ever to be elected to the office (James Buchanan, elected in 1857, was the first). After losing to Benjamin Harrison in 1889, Cleveland was again elected president in 1893, the only person so far to serve two separate, non-consecutive terms.
